

HPAT Candidate Interview Questions

1. Who? - Introduce yourself, biography, family, work, hobbies, interests, etc.
2. What? - What if any, other areas have you served the community. Boards, commissions, non-profits, volunteering, projects, accomplishments, etc.
3. Where? - What seat are you running for; City Council Ward, At Large, School Board, Legislative District, etc.
4. Why? - Why are you running for this seat? What are some of your ideas, agendas, plans, goals, etc.
5. Why? - Why should someone vote for you? Why are you different than your opponent(s)? Sell yourself and make a personal appeal to the voters.
(Look into the camera)

Each candidate will be allotted 15 minutes per interview. Please arrive a few minutes early.

Do not wear any bright green or lime green clothing - we use a green screen in our studio.

Put some thoughtfulness into your answers, practice your responses, even time yourself as to be able to fully use your time allotment wisely.
